## **Promises for Help with Prayer**

For at that time I will change the speech of the peoples to a pure speech, that all of them may call upon the name of the LORD and serve Him with one accord.

Zephaniah 3:9

And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy...

Zechariah 12:10

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans 8:26-27

Because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

Galatians 4:6

## **Promises to Answer Prayer**

I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.

2 Samuel 22:4

If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

2 Chronicles 7:14

Because your heart was tender and you humbled yourself before God when you heard His words against this place and its inhabitants, and you have humbled yourself before me and have torn your clothes and wept before me, I also have heard you, declares the LORD.

2 Chronicles 34:27

Then man prays to God, and He accepts him; he sees His face with a shout of joy, and He restores to man His righteousness.

Job 33:26

Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.

Psalms 2:8

But know that the LORD has set apart the godly for Himself; the LORD hears when I call to Him.

Psalms 4:3

I sought the LORD, and He answered me and delivered me from all my fears. Those who look to Him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed.

Psalms 72:12

In the day of my trouble I call upon you, for you answer me.

Psalms 86:7

When He calls to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation.

Psalms 91:15-16

Moses and Aaron were among His priests, Samuel also was among those who called upon His name. They called to the LORD, and He answered them.

Psalms 99:6

He regards the prayer of the destitute and does not despise their prayer.

Psalms 102:17

Out of my distress I called on the LORD; the LORD answered me and set me free.

Psalms 118:5

The LORD is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth. He fulfills the desire of those who fear Him; He also hears their cry and saves them.

Psalms 145:18-19

You shall weep no more. He will surely be gracious to you at the sound of your cry. As soon as He hears it, He answers you.

Isaiah 30:19

Then shall Your light break forth like the dawn, and Your healing shall spring up speedily; Your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the LORD shall be Your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; you shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.'

Isaiah 58:8-9

From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for Him.

Isaiah 64:4

Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.

Jeremiah 29:12-13

Daniel 10:12

At the beginning of your pleas for mercy a word went out, and I have come to tell it to you, for you are greatly loved.

Daniel 9:23

O Ephraim, what have I to do with idols? It is I who answer and look after you. I am like an evergreen cypress; from me comes your fruit.

Hosea 14:8

Your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

Matthew 6:8

For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.

Matthew 7:8

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

Matthew 7:11

Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be Yours.

Mark 11:24

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to Your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!

Luke 11:13

Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

John 14:13-14

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

John 15:7

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, He may give it to you.

John 15:16

In that day you will ask nothing of me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, He will give it to you. Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

Through Him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:2

This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in Him.

Ephesians 3:11-12

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us.

Ephesians 3:20

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:6-7

### **Promises to Those Who Trust God**

And he believed the LORD, and He counted it to him as righteousness.

Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, whose trust is the LORD. He is like a tree planted by water, that sends out its roots by the stream, and does not fear when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and is not anxious in the year of drought, for it does not cease to bear fruit.

### **Promises of The Holy Spirit’s Powerful Ministry**

Until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is deemed a forest.

Isaiah 32:15

I will put my Spirit within you, and you shall live.

Ezekiel 37:14

I will not hide my face anymore from them, when I pour out my Spirit upon the house of Israel, declares the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 39:29

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit.

Joel 2:28-29

He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Matthew 3:11

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!  
Luke 11:13

And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.  
Luke 24:49

On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of His heart will flow rivers of living water.'" Now this He said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.  
John 7:37-39

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will He do, because I am going to the Father.  
John 14:12

And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, to be with you forever even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. You know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.  
John 14:16-17

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.  
John 14:26-27

When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth, for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak, and He will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, for He will take what is mine and declare it to you.  
John 16:13-14

And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

John 20:22

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

Acts 1:8

God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

Romans 5:5

But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code.

Romans 7:6

For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

Romans 8:13

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"

Romans 8:14-15

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

Romans 8:16

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

Romans 15:13

But, as it is written, "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love Him" – these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.

1 Corinthians 2:9-10

To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.  
1 Corinthians 12:7

All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as He wills.  
1 Corinthians 12:11

Who has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.  
2 Corinthians 3:6

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.  
2 Corinthians 3:17-18

And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"  
Galatians 4:6

Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.  
Galatians 5:16

But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.  
Galatians 5:18

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.  
Galatians 5:22-23

For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.  
Galatians 6:8

In Him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of Your salvation, and believed in Him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of His glory.

Ephesians 1:13-14

That according to the riches of His glory He may grant you to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.

Ephesians 3:16-17

I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance.

Philippians 1:19

Our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction.

1 Thessalonians 1:5

But you have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge.

1 John 2:20

But the anointing that you received from the Father in you, and you have no need that anyone should teach you. But as His anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie – just as it has taught you, abide in Him.

1 John 2:27

Prayer for the ministry of the Spirit in the church: Now therefore, O our God, listen to the prayer of your servant and to his pleas for mercy, and for Your own sake, O Lord, make Your face to shine upon Your sanctuary, which is desolate.

Daniel 9:17

### **Promises to Believers Struggling with Sin**

I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves. And I have broken the bars of your yoke and made you walk erect.

Leviticus 26:13

For the LORD Your God is gracious and merciful and will not turn away His face from you, if you return to Him.

2 Chronicles 30:9

He sent from on high, he took me; he drew me out of many waters. He rescued me from my strong enemy and from those who hated me, for they were too mighty for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the LORD was my support.

Psalms 18:16-18

Blessed be the LORD, for he has wondrously shown His steadfast love to me when I was in a besieged city.

Psalms 31:21

For the LORD hears the needy and does not despise His own people who are prisoners.

Psalms 69:33

Return, faithless Israel, declares the LORD. I will not look on you in anger, for I am merciful, declares the LORD; I will not be angry forever.

Jeremiah 3:12

“Return, O faithless sons; I will heal your faithlessness.” “Behold, we come to you, for you are the LORD our God.”

Jeremiah 3:22

With weeping they shall come, and with pleas for mercy I will lead them back, I will make them walk by brooks of water, in a straight path in which they shall not stumble, for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn.

Jeremiah 31:9

For thus says the Lord GOD: I will deal with you as you have done, you who have despised the oath in breaking the covenant, yet I will remember my covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I will establish for you an everlasting covenant.

Ezekiel 16:59-60

They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols and their detestable things, or with any of their transgressions. But I will save them from all the backslidings in which they have sinned, and will cleanse them; and they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Ezekiel 37:23

I will heal their apostasy; I will love them freely, for my anger has turned from them.

Hosea 14:4

I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph. I will bring them back because I have compassion on them, and they shall be as though I had not rejected them, for I am the LORD their God and I will answer them. Then Ephraim shall become like a mighty warrior, and their hearts shall be glad as with wine. Their children shall see it and be glad; their hearts shall rejoice in the LORD.

Zechariah 10:6-7

I will consume your uncleanness out of you.

Ezekiel 22:15

I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

Ezekiel 36:25-27

### **Promises to Give His People Strength**

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him.

2 Chronicles 16:9

Cast your burden on the LORD, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved.

Psalms 55:22

Awesome is God from His sanctuary; the God of Israel – he is the one who gives power and strength to His people. Blessed be God!

Psalms 68:35

Then we shall not turn back from you; give us life, and we will call upon Your name!

Psalms 80:18

The LORD is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation.

Psalms 118:14

On the day I called, you answered me; my strength of soul you increased.

Psalms 138:3

In that day the LORD of hosts will be a crown of glory, and a diadem of beauty, to the remnant of His people, and a spirit of justice to him who sits in judgment, and strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate.

Isaiah 28:5-6

For I will satisfy the weary soul, and every languishing soul I will replenish.

Jeremiah 31:25

Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of hosts.

Zechariah 4:6

I will make them strong in the LORD, and they shall walk in His name, declares the LORD.

Zechariah 10:12

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

Romans 8:37

He will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

Romans 14:4

Now to Him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ.

Romans 16:25

We have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us.

2 Corinthians 4:7

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

2 Corinthians 12:9

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

Philippians 2:12-13

For this I toil, struggling with all His energy that He powerfully works within me.

Colossians 1:29

But the Lord stood by me and strengthened me, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it.

2 Timothy 4:17

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of His glory with great joy.

Jude 1:24

For the LORD will vindicate His people and have compassion on His servants, when He sees that their power is gone and there is none remaining, bond or free.

Deuteronomy 32:36

It may be that the LORD will work for us, for nothing can hinder the LORD from saving by many or by few.

1 Samuel 14:6

He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength. Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

Isaiah 40:28-31

I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship.

Exodus 31:3
